Heating & Hot Water Design (HSD1) Course Coming Soon.....

The Heating and hot Water course is a 3 day course, designed to provide knowledge and understanding of domestic heating systems. It covers Design & Specifications for new installs as well as looking at existing systems from gravity to sealed installations.

It also covers hot water storage cylinders, open vented and unvented design.

Additional Scopes – NEW REGULATIONS

As from 1st October 2018, newly qualified engineers will have to be registered with Gas Safe for a minimum of 6 (six) months before they will be able to extend their range of scope. This means, for example, any newly qualified engineer, starting with Domestic Natural Gas would have to wait six months after registering with Gas Safe before they could sit an LPG or other Course.
